What is the Length of Each Route?

The total length of all routes is 143 km (88 miles), with each route running for a minimum of 5.9 km (3.7 miles) and a maximum of 24.2 km (15 miles). If you're planning on using Dubai's public transport to get around, it's good to know which stops are located close together; within one kilometer, metro users will find 12 stations.

What are the Primary Destinations?

As a tourist, you probably want to see some of Dubai's popular landmarks, right? To make your metro trip efficient, take advantage of its close proximity to these main destinations. Al Jafiliya is in walking distance of Mall of Emirates, Palm Jumeirah, The World Islands (only 15 minutes by metro), Wild Wadi Water Park and Safa Park.

Is there another way to view the map?

Similar to how Google Maps allows users to zoom in, zoom out, or even fly over a city, Dubai's metro system offers an easy-to-navigate way to get around town quickly. And with updates made annually so that passengers can get information relevant to their journey (for example, if they need transfer stops in certain areas), getting around town is as easy as tapping away on your smartphone or tablet.
